**The objective is to practice what has
been explained during day 1**



Rules of the game

- Attendants divided into small team working on the same (bottom-up) project idea
- Limited time to prepare/defend a mini-project (ppt slides and designated presenter).
- Stick to predefined presentation template (15 min maximum/presentation).
- No questions allowed during presentation.
- When the presentation ends the team leaves the room.
- The rest act as “evaluators” (course teacher acts as “nasty evaluator”).
- Scoring is given according to presentation template.
- Presenting team comes back and listens to score.

Mini-project requirements

- Project idea.
- 3 to 4 organizations as consortium (real or invented).
- Maximum 4 ESRs.
- Time 2 and ½ h to prepare the presentation.

TIP: try to be creative using tables diagrams, drawings.

- What is your R&D&I project idea about?
- What is your main objective?
- What are your secondary objectives?
- Who is your consortium?

Impact

(max. 2 slides min font 16)

- ❑ Why is your project value chain?
- ❑ What is its industrial value?
- ❑ What is its societal value?
- ❑ How the consortium will create and deliver impact (i.e. dissemination and exploitation)?

Training

(max. 2 slides min font 16)

- What are your project R&D&I training activities?
- What are your project non R&D&I training activities?
- What are the ESRs individual projects (description and main objective)?
- How is the secondment plan done?



Implementation

(max. 2 slides min font 16)

- ❑ What is your project WP structure? Define leaders, participants and objectives.
- ❑ What is your project management structure?
- ❑ How the ESRs individual projects related to the WPs?
